

## **Shir Ami Rabbinic Intern Host Responsibilities as of February 2017**

### **Friday**

- Pick intern up from the Oakland airport and take him/her to the Comfort Inn on 2532 Castro Valley Blvd., Castro Valley
- Provide a Shabbat dinner either at your home, at a restaurant or pot luck (if one is scheduled).
- Bring intern to Shir Ami for Friday night services (arrive at least 20 minutes before service time)
- Attend services. Optional: Light and Bless Shabbat candles at start of service.
- Drive intern back to hotel after services

### **Saturday** (subject to discussion depending on intern's schedule)

- Provide transportation, if needed, to Shir Ami Saturday morning (sometimes there is B'nai Mitzvah tutoring)
- Provide lunch
- Provide transportation for adult education (can be morning, afternoon or evening)
- Provide dinner & transportation back to the hotel

### **Sunday**

- Coordinate with the intern about arrival time at Shir Ami on Sunday morning.
- Diana Z will provide transportation for the intern to the airport

Reminder: Hosting our student rabbis is both a responsibility and an opportunity; you have the opportunity to get to know each other better and you have the responsibility to get the student to his or her obligations on time. The intern is required to have a block of downtime during the weekend. Please follow the student's guidance as to how many activities to include.
